

CHAMPAGNE

Moet & Chandon Brut Imperial R2,100

The palate is fruity with a medium body, well-balanced, exhibiting flavors of light toast, Gala apple, honey and ginger, with smoke and mineral notes underscoring hints of pear and peach

Moet & Chandon Nectar Imperial R2,500

The captivating density of exotic fruits (pineapple, mango). The silky firmness of stonefruits (mirabelle plum, apricot). The brisk freshness of grapefruit notes.

Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label R2,235

Yellow Label Brut is structured by Pinot Noir, the true backbone of the wine. It offers flavors of pear, peach, and pastry enhanced by a touch of dried fruit from aging on lees, which gives it a true aromatic richness.

Dom Perignon Blanc R14,300

The mouthfeel is elegant, expressing luxuriant simplicity and precision. The refined and silky foundation becomes more pronounced at the heart. The finish is dominated by a salinity that leaves a deep sensation of consistency.

SPARKLING WINE

Graham Beck Brut R545

Light yeasty aromas, limey fresh fruit on the nose and rich creamy complexity on the palate. The exceptionally fine mousse contributes the freshness and finesse.

Krone Night Nectar R660

Plush and inviting with enchanting, complex flavours of jasmine, honeycomb, quince, melon and tarte tatin. The cleansing acidity is in balance with the elegant, richness of the dosage and autolytic layering.

Babylonstoren Sprankel R2,300

Perfectly rounded and balanced with crisp acidity, ripe fruit and palate-cleansing mousse, inviting another sip.


Durbanville Hills Sparkling Sauvignon Blanc R360

The bubble in the wine elevates both the greener and the riper tropical elements of the Sauvignon Blanc, resulting in a delightful bouquet of green pepper, kiwi fruit, fig and gooseberry.

ROSE

Babylonstoren Mourvedre Rose R560

A single sip leads to the delightful discovery of crushed pomegranate, the sweet freshness of watermelon and a subtle punch of acidity.



WHITE WINE

Klein Constantia Sauvignon Blanc R630

Light & bright in appearance. Fresh aromas of grapefruit, limes and kiwi burst on the nose. The palate is moreish with balanced flavours of quince, citrus blossom, umami and a bittersweet aspect. Salivating with fresh salinity, lively and a vibrant acidity. Textured and expressive, the wine concludes with a long crisp finish.

Springfield Life from Stone Sauvignon Blanc R630

Primary fruit flavours are citrus-led with lime as well as green apple, passion fruit, peach and distinctive gooseberry coming to the fore.

Babylonstoren Chenin Blanc R500

Intriguing white peach and ripe pineapple fragrance with underlying lemon curd, which makes this wine hard to resist.

Babylonstoren Chardonnay R1,260

A rich nose of lemon curd and freshly baked butter biscuits. The fruity core is perfectly balanced by layers of oak spice, vanilla and roasted almonds.

RED WINE

Rupert and Rothschild Classique Red Blend R780

Aromas of red plum, raspberries and cherries are prominent, layered with forest floor and oak spice expressed as toasted caramel and walnut. The palate has a fresh red fruit core with soft-textured tannins and good persistence.

Babylonstoren Babel R760

Crushed mulberry, blackberry and plum flavours with well-judged oak maturation, adding layers of sweet spice, vanilla and dark chocolate.

Babylonstoren Nebukadnesar R2300

Wondrous graphite and cedar element which seamlessly incorporates every other component – brambles, spiced black cherries, blueberries, plums, origanum, thyme, fresh walnuts and a beautiful floral element of violets and pansies.

Beau Constantia Aidan R1250

A spicy, fruit forward and plush new world style blend. The balance of rich texture and freshness gives this wine vibrancy, making it the perfect fit for Aidan.

Beau Constantia Pas De Nom Red R730

Pas de Nom meaning Without Name is something so sublime that it could only be inspired by an individual of character, strength and temerity. This range of wines is a tribute to our late farm manager, Japie Bronn, who has been instrumental in developing the vineyards on some of the steepest slopes in the Cape.
